FACTUAL BASIS

Should this matter have gone to trial, the government would have proved through the introduction of competent testimony and admissible tangible exhibits, including documentary evidence, the following to support the allegations charged by the government in the indictment now pending against the defendant, **DEANDRE ROSE, a/k/a "WHITE BOY"** (herein "**ROSE**"). (Unless otherwise noted, the acts and events listed herein occurred in the Eastern District of Louisiana.)

On or about October 14, 2014, two Gretna police officers, in the area of Milton & Pratt Streets, examined a 2010 Acura TSC parked illegally at the intersection of Milton and Pratt Streets using handheld flashlights. Inside the vehicle was seen a pistol and a bag of crack cocaine. Officers set up observation on the vehicle and waited for the occupants to return.


Three males (one of them being **ROSE**) and one female walked up to the vehicle. One of the males used a remote keyless entry system to open the vehicle, at which point all four people entered the vehicle. **ROSE** entered the rear passenger's seat. The Gretna Police Department then approached the vehicle and arrested all of the occupants. Additional investigation into the vehicle uncovered that it did not belong to either of the suspects, but had been loaned to one of the males by another individual and that there had been no firearms in the car prior to the owner


loaning it.


**ROSE**—having been previously convicted of felonies in Orleans Parish Criminal District Court in case numbers 496-356 “C” and 504-246 “F”—was placed under arrest for being a felon in possession of a Springfield model XDM, .45-caliber semi-automatic pistol, bearing serial number MG539525, which was underneath the rear of the front passenger’s seat and accessible to **ROSE**. A search of the vehicle uncovered an additional two pistols as well as the bag of crack cocaine which had previously been seen by the investigating officers. Investigation into each of the recovered weapons indicated that they had been reported stolen based on a check of the serial numbers through the NCIC system. Further investigation revealed that the firearm had previously travelled in interstate commerce.

**LIMITED NATURE OF FACTUAL BASIS**

This proffer of evidence is not intended to constitute a complete statement of all facts known by **DEANDRE ROSE** and the government, but rather is a minimum statement of facts intended to prove the necessary factual predicate for the guilty plea. The limited purpose of this proffer is to demonstrate that there exists a sufficient legal basis for **DEANDRE ROSE**’s plea of guilty to the charged offense.
