The United States Attorney charges that:

COUNT 1

A. <u>AT ALL TIMES MATERIAL HEREIN</u>:

- The defendant, LEXY LOPEZ-BATEMAN, was employed by the United States
 Postal Service (USPS).
- 2. The Federal Employees Compensation Act (FECA) provides certain disability compensation benefits for civilian employees of the United States Government who sustain on-the-job injuries or employment-related occupational illness or disease. The program is administered by the U.S. Department of Labor (USDOL), Office of Workers' Compensation

Programs (OWCP). The receipt of benefits is authorized under Title 5, chapter 81, subchapter I of the United States Code.

- 3. Among other benefits, OWCP pays all covered wage loss, medical bills, and other related costs associated with making the injured employee (claimant) whole. OWCP allows federal employees who sustain on-the-job injuries to receive medical payments and compensation benefits, including reimbursement for medically-related travel.
- 4. Claimants seeking medically-related travel reimbursements are required to complete OWCP Form 957, Medical Travel Refund Request. OWCP Form 957 requires claimants to substantiate their medically-related travel claims; including the date of the medically-related travel, the starting and ending locations of the medically-related travel, the name and address of the medical facility, the total distance in miles traveled, and any parking or toll fees incurred.
- 5. Beginning on or about April 2, 2015, through on or about June 23, 2017, in the Eastern District of Louisiana and elsewhere, the defendant, LEXY LOPEZ-BATEMAN, knowingly and willfully submitted false, fictitious, and fraudulent statements or representations to USDOL OWCP regarding her medically-related travel claims. Specifically, LEXY LOPEZ-BATEMAN submitted OWCP Form 957, Medical Travel Refund Request, forms on which she falsely stated to USDOL OWCP that she incurred expenses for travel for medical treatment when, in fact, she did not incur such expenses. In total, LEXY LOPEZ-BATEMAN received a total of \$16,851.10 in benefits as a result of her fraudulent representations.

B. THE OFFENSE

Beginning on or about April 2, 2015, and continuing through on or about June 23, 2017, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **LEXY LOPEZ-BATEMAN**, did knowingly and willfully make false, fictitious, and fraudulent statements or representations in connection with an application for receipt of compensation or other benefit or payment under subchapter I or III of chapter 81 of Title 5 of the United States Code, to wit: false OWCP Form 957 claims for medically-related travel expenses, and as result falsely obtained benefits in excess of \$1,000; in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1920.
