FACTUAL BASIS

Were this matter brought to trial, the United States would prove, through competent evidence, the following beyond a reasonable doubt.

On or about December 14, 2017, Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) agents encountered the defendant **EDY GARCIA-BANEGAS** at the Jefferson Parish Sheriff's Office. ICE agents conducted an immigration interview where **EDY GARCIA-BANEGAS** confirmed his identity and admitted that he was a Honduran citizen without immigration documents that would permit him to be in the United States.


Law enforcement records revealed that **EDY GARCIA-BANEGAS** is, in fact, a citizen of Honduras illegally present in the United States and that he had been deported and thereafter removed from the United States most recently on or about January 6, 2012. Notwithstanding, on an unknown date but since his last removal, **EDY GARCIA-BANEGAS** unlawfully reentered the United States without the requisite consent from the United States Attorney General or her designated successor, the Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security, to apply for


readmission or receive permission to reenter the United States.
