FACTUAL BASIS


Should this matter have gone to trial, the government would have demonstrated, through the introduction of competent testimony and other admissible evidence, the following facts, beyond a reasonable doubt, to support the allegations in the bill of information now pending against ANITRA SMITH (“SMITH”):

On November 9, 2016, SMITH encountered a letter carrier employed by the United States Postal Service. The encounter began when the letter carrier delivered mail to SMITH’S address. SMITH and the letter carrier exchanged words. Later, SMITH drove to the block where the letter carrier was delivering mail to a different address. SMITH exited her vehicle and approached the letter carrier with an aluminum baseball bat. SMITH and the letter carrier were standing a distance away from each other. SMITH threatened the letter carrier with the baseball bat. A neighbor intervened and SMITH went back to her car and drove home.


