FACTUAL BASIS

Were this matter brought to trial, the United States would prove, through competent evidence, the following beyond a reasonable doubt.

On or about March 8, 2018, Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) agents encountered the defendant **FERNANDO PEREZ-YOK, a/k/a Luis Chilel-Ramirez**, after he had been released from St. Tammany Sheriff Office's custody in connection with traffic violations. Mr. **PEREZ-YOK** was a passenger in the vehicle.

Law enforcement records revealed that **FERNANDO PEREZ-YOK, a/k/a/ Luis Chilel-Ramirez** is, in fact, a citizen of Guatemala illegally present in the United States and that he had been deported and thereafter removed from the United States most recently on or about May 29, 2012. Notwithstanding, on an unknown date but since his last removal, **FERNANDO PEREZ-YOK, a/k/a/ Luis Chilel-Ramirez** unlawfully reentered the United States without the requisite


consent from the United States Attorney General or her designated successor, the Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security, to apply for readmission or receive permission to reenter the United States.
