The Grand Jury charges that:

COUNTS 1-11  
(Theft of Mail)

A. AT ALL TIMES MATERIAL HEREIN:

1. The defendant, **BRIA DAVIS** (“**DAVIS**”), was employed by the United States Postal Service as a Postal Support Employee/Sales Distribution Clerk.

2. **DAVIS** worked in the Slidell Main Post Office and the West Slidell Station Post Office, both located in the Eastern District of Louisiana.

3. **DAVIS** worked at the retail window counter and performed a variety of tasks including Postal sales, delivering mail to customer P.O. Boxes, and assisting customers with P.O. Box related business.

**B. THE OFFENSE:**

In or on about the dates listed below, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **BRIA DAVIS**, an employee of the United States Postal Service, did knowingly steal, abstract, remove from any letter, package, bag, and mail any article and thing contained therein having been entrusted to her and which came into her possession, intended to be conveyed by mail according to the below table:

**COUNT 12**  
(Delay or Destruction of Mail)

**A. AT ALL TIMES MATERIAL HEREIN:**

The allegations contained in Part A of Counts 1-11 are hereby re-alleged and incorporated herein by reference.

**B. THE OFFENSE:**

Beginning in or about September 2016, to on or about January 18, 2017, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **BRIA DAVIS**, being a Postal Service employee, did unlawfully secret, destroy, detain, delay, and open letters, postal cards, packages, bags, and mail entrusted to her and which came into her possession, and which were intended to be conveyed by mail and carried and delivered by any carrier and other employees of the Postal Service, and forwarded through and delivered from any post office and station thereof established by the authority of the Postmaster General and the Postal Service, to wit: **DAVIS** unlawfully detained and delayed approximately 10 pieces of U.S. Mail that were found in her personal vehicle by

special agents with the Postal Service, Office of Inspector General; in violation of Title 18,  
United States Code, Section 1703(a).
