
FACTUAL BASIS

Were this matter brought to trial, the United States would prove, through competent evidence, the following beyond a reasonable doubt.

On or about August 26, 2018, Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) agents encountered the defendant **GERMAN ALFREDO MOLINA-LARA**, in connection with a traffic stop conducted by Slidell Police Department in St. Tammany Parish. **GERMAN ALFREDO MOLINA-LARA** admitted to agents that he is a citizen of Honduras and had unlawfully reentered the United States.

Law enforcement records revealed that **GERMAN ALFREDO MOLINA-LARA** is, in fact, a citizen of Honduras illegally present in the United States and that he had been deported and thereafter removed from the United States on or about June 12, 2008. Notwithstanding, on an unknown date but since his last removal, **GERMAN ALFREDO MOLINA-LARA** unlawfully reentered the United States without the requisite consent from the United States Attorney General

or his designated successor, the Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security, to apply for readmission or receive permission to reenter the United States.
