The United States Attorney charges that:

COUNT 1  
(False Statement)

A. THE OFFENSE:

On or about August 8, 2015, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, and elsewhere, the defendant, **LEOPOLDO RODRIGUEZ-AGUILERA (a/k/a Danny Josue Rodriguez-Aguilera)**, did willfully and knowingly make a materially false, fictitious, and fraudulent statement and representation in a matter within the jurisdiction of the executive branch of the Government of the United States, by providing a false statement related to his identity to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security during an immigration enforcement encounter. The statements and



representations were false because, as **LEOPOLDO RODRIGUEZ-AGUILERA** (a/k/a **Danny Josue Rodriguez-Aguilera**) then and there knew, his identity was not the same identity provided to federal law-enforcement authorities during an encounter with federal immigration officials.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1001.
