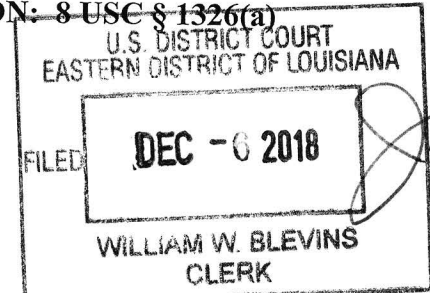

FACTUAL BASIS



Were this matter brought to trial, the United States would prove the following through competent evidence beyond a reasonable doubt.

On or about September 18, 2018, Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) agents encountered the defendant **ELVA RAMIREZ-LAMBERTO** in the Eastern District of Louisiana. **ELVA RAMIREZ-LAMBERTO** was a passenger in a vehicle stopped by Louisiana State Police for traffic violations near Covington, Louisiana. **ELVA RAMIREZ-LAMBERTO** admitted to agents that she is a native of Mexico and had unlawfully reentered the United States.

Law enforcement records revealed that **ELVA RAMIREZ-LAMBERTO** is, in fact, a native and citizen of Mexico illegally present in the United States. Further, the records reflect that **ELVA RAMIREZ-LAMBERTO** had been deported and thereafter removed from the United States on or about August 31, 2018. Notwithstanding, on an unknown date but since her last removal, **ELVA RAMIREZ-LAMBERTO** unlawfully reentered the United States without the requisite consent from the United States Attorney General
