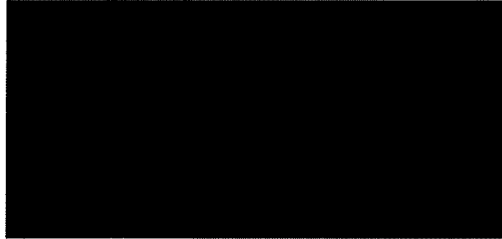
The Grand Jury charges that:

COUNT 1


