

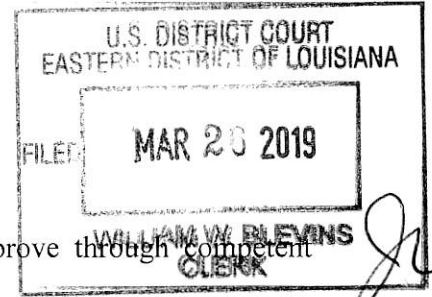

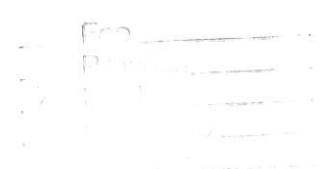
FACTUAL BASIS

Were this matter brought to trial, the United States would prove through competent evidence the following beyond a reasonable doubt.



Defendant **JORGE AGUILAR-PEREZ** is an alien assigned Alien Registration Number 099 679 878. He was ordered deported and removed from the United States most recently on or about May 25, 2006. According to U.S. immigration records, there is no record of **JORGE AGUILAR-PEREZ** ever having received express permission to reenter the United States from the Attorney General, Immigration Officer, or Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security. Notwithstanding, at an unknown place and unknown time and date, **JORGE AGUILAR-PEREZ** reentered the United States without inspection.

On December 20, 2018, Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) agents, Fugitive Operations Team, conducting surveillance during an immigration investigation encountered **JORGE AGUILAR-PEREZ** outside a residence at 2632 Dumaine Street, New Orleans. When ICE agents requested identification from **JORGE AGUILAR-PEREZ**, he complied and freely admitted that he was a citizen of Guatemala without the requisite documentation that would permit him to remain in the United States lawfully, **JORGE AGUILAR-PEREZ** further admitted that ICE had arrested him approximately eight years ago.



The U.S. immigration and law enforcement records confirmed that **JORGE AGUILAR-PEREZ** is a citizen of Guatemala unlawfully present in the United States.
