The Grand Jury charges that:

COUNT 1  
(Felon in Possession of a Firearm)

On or about April 27, 2018, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, JAVANTI COLER, did possess a firearm and ammunition, to wit: a Rugar P95 9mm semi-automatic handgun, serial number 312-87949 and 9mm caliber ammunition, said firearm and ammunition having been shipped and transported in interstate commerce, after having previously been convicted of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, to wit: a conviction on February 2, 2016, in the 32<sup>nd</sup> Judicial District Court for the State of Louisiana, Parish of Terrebonne, under case number 698571, for Simple Robbery, in violation of LA. R.S. 14:65; and a conviction on May 21, 2013, in the 17<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court for the State of Louisiana,

United States Code, Section 924(d)(1), and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), any firearm or ammunition involved in or used in the commission of said offenses, including but not limited to all firearms and ammunition identified in the foregoing allegations.

3. If any of the above-described property, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:

- a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third person;
- c. has been placed beyond jurisdiction of the Court;
- d. has been substantially diminished in value; or
- e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be divided without difficulty;

the United States shall, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p), seek forfeiture of any other property of the defendant up to the value of the above-described property.
