FACTUAL BASIS

The defendant, OMAR ELI PEREZ-MURCIA (hereinafter "MURCIA"), has agreed to plead guilty as charged to the one-count indictment charging him with illegal reentry of a previously removed alien in violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a).

Should this matter have gone to trial, the government would have proven, through the introduction of competent testimony and other admissible evidence, the following facts, beyond a reasonable doubt, to support the allegations in the indictment now pending against the defendant:

On January 28, 2019, MURCIA was arrested by the Jefferson Parish Sheriff's Office for sexual assault-carnal abuse in Jefferson Parish, Louisiana.

On February 22, 2019, Jefferson Parish released MURCIA to the custody of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security Immigration and Customs Enforcement (hereinafter "ICE").

During processing, MURCIA was interviewed and admitted to being a citizen of Honduras and illegally present in the United States. The agent then checked various immigration databases and determined that MURCIA was indeed a citizen of Honduras, and that he had no claim to United States citizenship. The record checks also confirmed that MURCIA had been removed from the United States on April 4, 2006, from San Antonio, Texas. Testimony of an official from AUSA Defendant g

Defense Counsel

U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services regarding record checks conducted through the Computer Linked Application Information Management System would show that the defendant, MURCIA, did not receive consent from the U.S. Attorney General or his designated successor, the Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security, to apply for readmission or receive permission to reenter the United States since the time of the defendant's previous removal.
