The Grand Jury charges that:

COUNT 1

(Distribution of a Controlled Dangerous Substance)

On or about May 9, 2018, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **JONATHAN WEBRE**, did knowingly and intentionally distribute five grams or more of methamphetamine, its salts, isomers, and salts of its isomers, a Schedule II Controlled Dangerous Substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(b).

COUNT 2

(Possession with the intent to Distribute a Controlled Dangerous Substance)

On or about May 2, 2019, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **JONATHAN WEBRE**, did knowingly and intentionally possess with the intent to distribute 50 grams or more of methamphetamine, its salts, isomers, and salts of its isomers, a Schedule II Controlled Dangerous Substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(A).

COUNT 3

(Felon in Possession of a Firearm)

On or about May 2, 2019, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **JONATHAN WEBRE**, knowing that he had been convicted of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, to wit: a conviction on October 14, 2013, in the 40th Judicial District Court for the State of Louisiana, Parish of St. John the Baptist, under case number 2013-CR-210 "C", for Simple Burglary, in violation of LA. R.S. 14:62; and a conviction on May 3, 2006, in the 40th Judicial District Court for the State of Louisiana, Parish of St. John the Baptist, under case number 2005-CR-590 "C", for Possession with the Intent to Distribute Marijuana, in violation of LA. R.S. 40:966; did knowingly possess a firearm and ammunition, to wit: a Phoenix Arms .22LR pistol (serial no. 4053677), and .22 caliber ammunition, said firearm and ammunition having been shipped and transported in interstate commerce, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2).

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

1. The allegations of Counts 1 through 3 are realleged and incorporated by reference as though set forth fully herein for the purpose of alleging forfeiture to the United States.

2. As a result of the offenses alleged in Counts 1 and 2, the defendant, **JONATHAN WEBRE**, shall forfeit to the United States pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853, any property constituting or derived from any proceeds obtained directly or indirectly as the result of said offenses, and any property used or intended to be used in any manner or part to commit or to facilitate the commission of said offenses.

3. As a result of the offenses alleged in Counts 1 through 3, the defendant, **JONATHAN WEBRE**, shall forfeit to the United States pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d)(1), and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), any firearm or ammunition involved in or used in the commission of said offenses, including but not limited to any firearm or ammunition described in the foregoing allegations.


4. If any of the above-described property, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:

- a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third person;
- c. has been placed beyond jurisdiction of the Court;
- d. has been substantially diminished in value; or
- e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be divided without difficulty;

the United States shall seek a money judgment and, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p), forfeiture of any other property of the defendant up to the value of said property.
