PEDRO MANOLO ARAGON-HERNANDEZ VIOLATION: 8 USC § 1326

FACTUAL BASIS

Were this matter brought to trial, the United States would prove the following through competent evidence beyond a reasonable doubt.

Defendant PEDRO MANOLO ARAGON-HERNANDEZ is an alien assigned Alien Registration Number 079 044 368. He was ordered deported and then removed from the United States on or about December 20, 2001. According to U.S. immigration records, there is no record of PEDRO MANOLO ARAGON-HERNANDEZ ever having received express permission to reenter the United States from the Attorney General, Immigration Officer, or Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security. Notwithstanding, at an unknown place and unknown time and date, PEDRO MANOLO ARAGON-HERNANDEZ reentered the United States without inspection.

On July 25, 2019, a St. Tammany Sherriff's Office deputy stopped PEDRO MANOLO ARAGON-HERNANDEZ in connection with a traffic violation along I-12 near mile marker 56 in St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana. The deputy cited PEDRO MANOLO ARAGON-HERNANDEZ for improper lane usage and driving without a license. The deputy believed the driver of the vehicle may be an illegal alien and therefore contacted the United States Border Patrol and Border Patrol Agent Gaudet responded to the scene. When Border Patrol Agents conducted

an immigration interview **PEDRO MANOLO ARAGON-HERNANDEZ** confirmed his identity and admitted that he was a citizen of Honduras unlawfully present in the United States.

U.S. immigration and law enforcement records confirmed that **PEDRO MANOLO ARAGON-HERNANDEZ** is a citizen of Honduras without the requisite documentation that would permit him to remain in the United States lawfully.
