The Grand Jury charges that:

COUNT 1

On or about October 10, 2019, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **EDWIN PONCE-MATAMOROS**, an alien, was found in the United States after having been officially deported and removed therefrom on or about March 17, 2017, and without the approval of the Attorney General of the United States or his designated successor, the Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security, as provided for in Title 6, United States Code, Sections

202(3), 202(4), and 557, having expressly consented to the defendant's reapplication for admission into the United States; all in violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a).


NOTICE OF SENTENCING ENHANCEMENT

Now comes the United States of America, by and through Peter G. Strasser, United States Attorney for the Eastern District of Louisiana, to give notice that on or about December 15, 2016, in the U. S. District Court, Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **EDWIN PONCE-MATAMOROS**, was convicted of Reentry of a Removed Alien in violation of 8 U.S.C. § 1326(a). Because of this felony conviction, if the defendant is convicted of a violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a), the defendant's sentence will be subject to a maximum sentence of imprisonment of not more than ten years. Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(b)(1).
