The Grand Jury charges that:

COUNT 1

(Attempted Bank Robbery)

On or about January 2, 2020, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **BERNELL BREAUX**, by force, violence, and intimidation, did attempt to take from the person and presence of another, money, belonging to and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of Gulf Coast Bank & Trust Company, located at 200 St. Charles Avenue, New Orleans, Louisiana, a bank whose deposits were then insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2113(a).

COUNT 2

(Bank Robbery)

On or about January 2, 2020, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **BERNELL BREAUX**, by force, violence, and intimidation, did take from the person and presence of another, money, namely \$302.00 in U.S. currency, belonging to and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of Capital One Bank, located at 4121 Canal Street, New Orleans, Louisiana, a bank whose deposits were then insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2113(a).

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

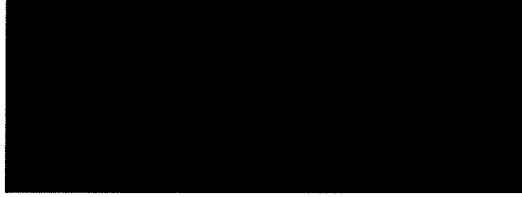
1. The allegations of Counts 1 and 2 are incorporated by reference as though set forth fully herein for the purpose of alleging forfeiture to the United States.

2. As a result of the offenses alleged in Counts 1 and 2, the defendant, **BERNELL BREAUX**, shall forfeit to the United States pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 981(a)(1)(C), and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), any property real or personal which constitutes or is derived from proceeds traceable to said offenses.


3. If any of the above-described property, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:

- a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third person;
- c. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court;
- d. has been substantially diminished in value; or
- e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be subdivided without difficulty;

the United States shall seek a money judgment and, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p), forfeiture of any other property of the defendant up to the value of said property.
