The Grand Jury charges that:

COUNT 1

(Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon)

On or about October 13, 2020, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **JAYLON JOHNSON**, knowing he had been previously convicted of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, to wit: a felony conviction on November 10, 2016, in the Orleans Parish Criminal District Court, Criminal Docket No. 524-410 "C," for Aggravated Criminal Damage to Property, in violation of La. R.S. 14:55, did knowingly possess a firearm, to wit: a Ruger, model SR9C, 9mm caliber, semi-automatic pistol, bearing serial number 332-48657, said firearm having been shipped and transported in interstate commerce, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2).

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

1. The allegation in Count 1 is incorporated in this Indictment by reference as though set forth fully herein for the purpose of alleging forfeiture to the United States.

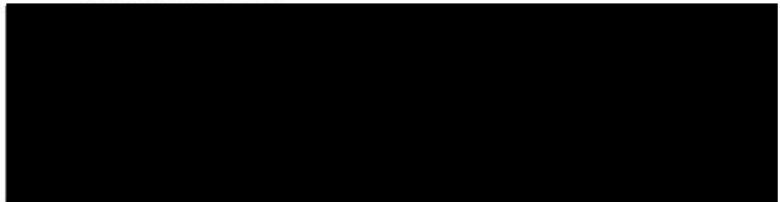
2. As a result of the offense alleged in Count 1, the defendant, **JAYLON JOHNSON**, shall forfeit to the United States pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d), and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), any firearm involved in or used in the commission of said offense, including but not limited to any firearm described above.

3. If any of the above-described property, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:

- a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third person;
- c. has been placed beyond jurisdiction of the Court;
- d. has been substantially diminished in value; or
- e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be divided without difficulty;

the United States shall seek a money judgment and, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p), forfeiture of any other property of the defendant up to the value of said property.
