FACTUAL BASIS

The above-named defendant, **HARRIS HENDERSON**, has agreed to plead guilty as charged to Count One of the Indictment now pending against him. Should this matter have proceeded to trial, the United States of America would have proven beyond a reasonable doubt, through the introduction of relevant, competent, and admissible testimonial, physical and demonstrative evidence, the following facts to support the allegation against the defendant, **HARRIS HENDERSON ("HENDERSON")**:

Unless stated otherwise, all of the facts set forth herein occurred within the Eastern District of Louisiana.

In January 2018, a confidential source (CS) informed agents of the Drug Enforcement Administration and the Terrebonne Parish Narcotics Task Force that HENDERSON sold methamphetamine in the Terrebonne Parish area. The CS also provided the agents with HENDERSON'S telephone number.

On February 7, 2018, agents used the CS to make a controlled purchase of two (2) ounces of methamphetamine from HENDERSON. At approximately 7:15 p.m., under the direction of agents, the CS called HENDERSON and asked to purchase two ounces of methamphetamine for \$800.00. HENDERSON directed the CS to travel to Schriever, Louisiana in Terrebonne Parish

then to call HENDERSON when he was close.

At 7:30 p.m., the CS traveled to Schriever. After he arrived, the CS called HENDERSON who instructed the CS to travel to the gym located on Highway 311. Agents then provided the CS \$800.00 in official agency funds.


While under agent surveillance, the CS traveled down Highway 311, also known as Main Project Road. HENDERSON then called the CS and told him that he would be parked on the side of the road. Agents observed HENDERSON in a white Dodge pick-up truck in the area.

At approximately 8:05 p.m., the CS met HENDERSON near Honey Suckle Drive and Main Project Road where they completed the transaction. The CS then returned to the agents and provided them with a clear baggie containing methamphetamine.

The drugs were analyzed at the DEA laboratory by Forensic Chemist Sabrina M. Snyder. The drugs tested positive for methamphetamine with a net weight of 55.17 grams and 99% purity, resulting in 54.61 grams of pure methamphetamine.


