The Grand Jury charges that:

COUNT 1 (Distribution of Methamphetamine)

On or about December 9, 2020, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **BEAU HEBERT**, did knowingly and intentionally distribute a quantity of a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of methamphetamine, a Schedule II controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C).

COUNT 2 (Possession with the Intent to Distribute Methamphetamine)

On or about January 21, 2021, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **BEAU HEBERT**, did knowingly and intentionally possess with the intent to distribute fifty (50) grams or more of methamphetamine, its salts, isomers, and salts of its isomers, a Schedule II controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(A)(viii).

COUNT 3 (Possession of a Firearm in Furtherance of Drug Trafficking)

On or about January 21, 2021, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **BEAU HEBERT**, did knowingly possess a firearm, to wit: a Glock, Model 43, 9 mm handgun, bearing serial number ZNX899, in furtherance of a drug trafficking crime for which he may be prosecuted in a court of the United States, that is, possession with the intent to distribute methamphetamine, a violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1), 841(b)(1)(A)(viii), as charged in Count 2 of this Indictment; in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(c)(1)(A)(i).

<u>COUNT 4</u> (Felon in Possession of a Firearm)

On or about January 21, 2021 in the Eastern District of Louisiana, defendant, **BEAU HEBERT**, knowing that he had previously been convicted of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, to wit: a conviction on July 12, 2016, in Louisiana 29th Judicial District Court, under Docket No. 16-CR-000316, for Possession with the Intent to Distribute Methamphetamine and Possession with the Intent to Distribute MDMA; a conviction on February 12, 2009, in Terrebonne Parish Judicial District Court, Docket No. 493194, for Transactions Involving Drug Proceeds and Possession of Marijuana 2nd; a conviction on February 12, 2009, in Terrebonne Parish Judicial District Court, Docket No. 454128, for Possession with the Intent to Distribute Marijuana, Possession of Cocaine, and Possession of a Schedule II Controlled

Dangerous Substance; and a conviction on June 11, 2007, in Terrebonne Parish Judicial District Court, under Docket No. 493194, for Transactions Involving Drug Proceeds, did knowingly possess in and affecting commerce, a firearm, to wit: a Glock, Model 43, 9 mm handgun, bearing serial number ZNX899, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2).

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

- 1. The allegations of Counts 1 through 4 of this Indictment are incorporated by reference as though set forth fully herein for the purpose of alleging forfeiture to the United States.
- 2. As a result of the offenses alleged in Counts 1 and 2, the defendant, **BEAU HEBERT**, shall forfeit to the United States pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853, any property constituting or derived from any proceeds obtained directly or indirectly as the result of said offense, and any property used or intended to be used in any manner or part to commit or to facilitate the commission of said offense.
- 3. As a result of the offenses alleged in Counts 1 through 4, the defendant, **BEAU HEBERT**, shall forfeit to the United States pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d)(1), and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), any firearm or ammunition involved in or used in the commission of said offenses, including but not limited to the following:

Glock, model 43, 9mm handgun, bearing serial number ZNX899.

- 4. If any of the above-described property, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:
 - a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
 - b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third person;
 - c. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court;
 - d. has been substantially diminished in value; or

e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be subdivided without difficulty;

the United States shall seek a money judgment and, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p), forfeiture of any other property of the defendant up to the value of said property.
