The Grand Jury charges that:

COUNT 1

On or about December 3, 2021, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **TORIN JENKINS**, knowing he had previously been convicted of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, to wit: a conviction on January 29, 2018, in the 24th Judicial District Court, Parish of Jefferson, under Case No. 16-04966, for possession of heroin, in violation of Louisiana R.S. 40:966.C, knowingly possessed a firearm, to wit, a Glock Model 36 .45 caliber semiautomatic pistol, serial number BAWL704, said firearm was in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2).

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

1. The allegation of Count 1 of this Indictment is incorporated by reference as though set forth fully herein for the purpose of alleging forfeiture to the United States.

2. As a result of the offense charged in Count 1, the defendant, **TORIN JENKINS**, shall forfeit to the United States pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d)(1), and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), any firearm or ammunition involved in or used in the commission of said offense, including but not limited to any of the following:

Glock model 36, .45 caliber semiautomatic pistol, bearing serial number BAWL704, loaded with seven (7) live rounds.

3. If any of the above-described property, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:

- a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third person;
- c. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court;
- d. has been substantially diminished in value; or
- e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be subdivided without difficulty;


the United States shall seek a money judgment and, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p), forfeiture of any other property of the defendant up to the value of said property.
