The Grand Jury charges that:

COUNT 1

On or about December 6, 2022, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **JEROME SHAQUILLE WILSON, aka "Rome,"** knowing that he had been convicted of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, to wit: a conviction on January 24, 2013 in the 22nd Judicial District Court for the State of Louisiana, Case No. 12-CR8-117406, for Aggravated Battery and a conviction on April 6, 2021 in the 22nd Judicial District Court for the State of Louisiana, Case No. 20-CR2-146035, for being a Felon in Possession of a Firearm, did knowingly possess a firearm and ammunition, to wit: a Sarsilmaz, model Sar9, 9mm semi-automatic pistol, bearing serial number [REDACTED] and 9mm ammunition, said

firearm and ammunition having been in and affecting interstate commerce, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(8).

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

1. The allegation of Count 1 of this Indictment is incorporated by reference as though set forth fully herein for the purpose of alleging forfeiture to the United States.

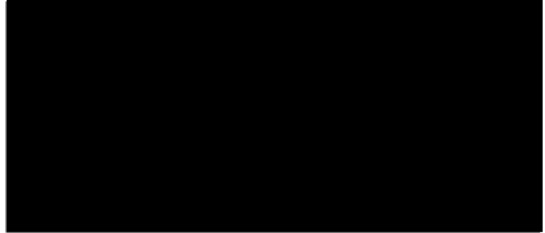
2. As a result of the offense alleged in Count 1, the defendant, **JEROME SHAQUILLE WILSON, aka "Rome,"** shall forfeit to the United States pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d)(1), and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), any firearm or ammunition involved in or used in the commission of said offense, including but not limited to any of the following:

Sarsilmaz, model Sar9, 9mm semi-automatic pistol, bearing serial number [REDACTED] and ammunition.

3. If any of the above-described property, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:

- a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third person;
- c. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court;
- d. has been substantially diminished in value; or
- e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be subdivided without difficulty;

the United States shall seek a money judgment and, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p), forfeiture of any other property of the defendant up to the value of said property.
