The Grand Jury charges that:

**COUNT 1**

(Conspiracy to Possess Firearms in furtherance of a Drug Trafficking Crime)

Beginning at a time unknown but continuing until on or about February 2, 2023, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **TYLAR REDDITT**, did knowingly and intentionally conspire, confederate, and agree with other persons known and unknown to the grand jury, to

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possess firearms in furtherance of a drug trafficking crime, as charged in Count 2 of this Indictment, all in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(o).

**COUNT 2**

(Conspiracy to Distribute Heroin)

Beginning at a time unknown but continuing until on or about February 2, 2023, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **TYLAR REDDITT**, did knowingly and intentionally conspire, confederate, and agree with other persons known and unknown to the grand jury, to possess with the intent to distribute a quantity of heroin, a Schedule I Controlled Dangerous Substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(C); all in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846.

**NOTICE OF FORFEITURE**

1. The allegations of Counts 1 and 2 of this Indictment are incorporated by reference as though set forth fully herein for the purpose of alleging forfeiture to the United States.

2. As a result of the offense alleged in Count 1, the defendant, **TYLAR REDDITT**, shall forfeit to the United States pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d)(1), and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), any firearm or ammunition involved in or used in the commission of said offense, including but not limited to any of the following:

Romarm/Cugir, Mini Draco, 7.62 caliber, pistol, bearing serial number [REDACTED];

Anderson Manufacturing, AM-15, multiple caliber, pistol, bearing serial number [REDACTED];

Matrix Aerospace, Midel M556-SC, .556 caliber firearm, bearing serial number [REDACTED];

7.62 caliber ammunition;

.223 caliber ammunition.

3. As a result of the offense alleged in Count 2, the defendant, **TYLAR REDDITT**, shall forfeit to the United States pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853, any property, constituting or derived from, any proceeds obtained, directly or indirectly, as the result of said offense, and any property, used or intended to be used, in any manner or part, to commit or to facilitate the commission of said offense.

4. If any of the above-described property, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:

- a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third person;
- c. has been placed beyond jurisdiction of the Court;
- d. has been substantially diminished in value; or
- e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be subdivided without difficulty;

the United States shall seek a money judgment and, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p), forfeiture of any other property of the defendant up to the value of said property.
