**INDICTMENT**

**COUNT ONE**

**THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:**

1. At all times material to this indictment, Metro PCS, located at 6342 Rising Sun Avenue, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania was a business engaged in and affecting interstate commerce and sold cell phones that were manufactured outside the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
2. On or about April 3, 2015, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

obstructed, delayed and affected commerce and the movement of articles and commodities in commerce, and attempted to do so, by robbery, in that defendant unlawfully took and obtained property, that is, money in the amount of approximately \$905, from employees of the Metro PCS, located at 6342 Rising Sun Avenue, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, against their will, by means of actual and threatened force, violence, and fear of injury, immediate and future, to their person and property, that is, by demanding money and brandishing a handgun.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951(a).

**COUNT TWO**

**THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:**

On or about April 3, 2015, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

**EDWIN JIMERSON**

knowingly used and carried a firearm, that is, a Smith & Wesson .38 revolver, serial no.

ACJ6628, during and in relation to a crime of violence for which he may be prosecuted in a court of the United States, that is, robbery which interferes with interstate commerce, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951(a), as charged in Count One of this indictment, and brandished that firearm.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(c)(1).

**COUNT THREE**

**THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:**

1. At all times material to this indictment, Metro PCS, located at 1414 Point Breeze Avenue, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania was a business engaged in and affecting interstate commerce and sold cell phones that were manufactured outside the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

2. On or about April 6, 2015, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

obstructed, delayed and affected commerce and the movement of articles and commodities in commerce, and attempted to do so, by robbery, in that defendant unlawfully took and obtained property, that is, money in the amount of approximately \$1500, from employees of the Metro PCS, located at 1414 Point Breeze Avenue, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, against their will, by means of actual and threatened force, violence, and fear of injury, immediate and future, to their person and property, that is, by demanding money and brandishing a handgun.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951(a).

**COUNT FOUR**

**THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:**

On or about April 6, 2015, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of  
Pennsylvania, defendant

**EDWIN JIMERSON**

knowingly used and carried a firearm, that is, a Smith & Wesson .38 revolver, serial no.  
ACJ6628, during and in relation to a crime of violence for which he may be prosecuted in a court  
of the United States, that is, robbery which interferes with interstate commerce, in violation of  
Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951(a), as charged in Count Three of this indictment, and  
brandished that firearm.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(c)(1).

**COUNT FIVE**

**THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:**

1. At all times material to this indictment, Metro PCS, located at 7219 Frankford Avenue, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania was a business engaged in and affecting interstate commerce and sold cell phones that were manufactured outside the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

2. On or about April 8, 2015, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

**EDWIN JIMERSON**

obstructed, delayed and affected commerce and the movement of articles and commodities in commerce, and attempted to do so, by robbery, in that defendant unlawfully took and obtained property, that is, money in the amount of approximately \$200, from an employee of the Metro PCS, located at 7219 Frankford Avenue, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, against her will, by means of actual and threatened force, violence, and fear of injury, immediate and future, to her person and property, that is, by demanding money and brandishing a handgun.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951(a).

**COUNT SIX**

**THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:**

On or about April 8, 2015, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

**EDWIN JIMERSON**

knowingly used and carried a firearm, that is, a Smith & Wesson .38 revolver, serial no.

ACJ6628, during and in relation to a crime of violence for which he may be prosecuted in a court of the United States, that is, robbery which interferes with interstate commerce, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951(a), as charged in Count Five of this indictment, and brandished that firearm.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(c)(1).

**NOTICE OF FORFEITURE**

**THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:**

As a result of the violations of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 924(c)(1),  
set forth in this indictment, defendant

**EDWIN JIMERSON**

shall forfeit to the United States of America the firearm and ammunition involved in the  
commission of such offenses, including, but not limited to, a Smith & Wesson .38 revolver,  
serial no. ACJ6628, loaded with five live rounds of ammunition.

All pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), and Title 18,  
United States Code, Section 924(d).
