**INDICTMENT**

**COUNT ONE**

**THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:**

On or about June 17, 2014, in Northampton County, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

**JED BERNARD CONNALLY**

knowingly possessed a border crossing card, permit, and document prescribed by statute and regulation for entry into and as evidence of authorized stay and employment in the United States, that is, a United States passport card, knowing it was forged, counterfeited, altered, falsely made, procured by means of false claim and statement, and otherwise unlawfully obtained and procured by fraud.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1546(a).
