**INDICTMENT**

**COUNT ONE**

**THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:**

On or about June 28, 2015, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

**MIRNA CHACON-ORDONEZ,  
a/k/a “Nancy Estefany Chacon-Ordonez,”  
a/k/a “Mirna Chacon-Del Cid,”  
a/k/a “Mirna Chacon,”**

an alien, and native and citizen of Guatemala, who had previously been deported and removed from the United States on or about May 21, 2000, January 26, 2009, and October 2, 2009, was found in the United States, having knowingly and unlawfully reentered the United States without first applying to the Attorney General of the United States or his successor, the Secretary for Homeland Security (Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202(3), (4) and 557), for permission to reapply for admission, and without receiving in response the express consent of the Attorney General or his successor to reapply for admission.

In violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a) and (b)(1).
