INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about September 15, 2015, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

STEPHEN GREGORY PETTIWAY

maliciously damaged and destroyed, by means of fire, a building and equipment contained therein, used in interstate commerce and in activities affecting interstate commerce, that is, each of the following businesses and residential properties located in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania:

- (a) Maze Hospitality Group, 208 South 13th Street;
- (b) Gramercy Building, 210 South 13th Street; and
- (c) Chancellor Apartments, 206 South 13th Street.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 844(i).
