INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about June 12, 2015, in Allentown, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,
defendant

**VICTOR MORALES,
a/k/a "Self,"**

having been convicted in a court of the State of New Jersey of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, knowingly possessed in and affecting interstate commerce a firearm, that is, a Smith and Wesson, Model SW40GVE, .40 caliber semi-automatic pistol, serial number: RBA0822, loaded with thirteen live rounds of ammunition in the magazine and one live round in the chamber.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1).

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

As a result of the violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1), set forth in this indictment, defendant


**VICTOR MORALES,

shall forfeit to the United States of America the firearm and ammunition involved in the commission of this violation, including, but not limited to: one Smith and Wesson, Model SW40GVE, .40 caliber semi-automatic pistol, serial number: RBA0822, and loaded with thirteen live rounds of ammunition in the magazine and one live round in the chamber.
