**INFORMATION**

**THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY CHARGES THAT:**


Between on or about September 11, 2015, and on or about October 2, 2015, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

**MARC FOX**

knowingly caused the transmission of programs, information, codes and commands and as a result of such conduct intentionally caused damage without authorization to a protected computer. That is, defendant FOX sent commands to a computer hosting telephone call routing instructions for customer telephone calls to UGI Utilities, Inc. (UGI), a supplier of natural gas to customers in Pennsylvania, and without authorization intentionally impaired the integrity of the data, system and information of the system for routing calls within UGI by intentionally changing passwords and permissions and by rerouting emergency calls to UGI during certain time periods so that these emergency calls were not directed to the proper UGI telephone representatives, thus delaying the response to these high priority calls, all of which caused a loss of at least \$5,000, and which caused

a threat to public health and safety.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1030(a)(5)(A).
