INFORMATION

COUNT ONE

THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY CHARGES THAT:

On or about July 17, 2015, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,
defendant

ULRIC MILLER

knowingly possessed certain matter, namely several internal hard drives, which contained visual depictions that had been shipped and transported using a means and facility of interstate and foreign commerce and in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce. The production of these visual depictions involved the use of minors engaging in sexually explicit conduct and the visual depictions were of minors engaging in sexually explicit conduct. At least one of the visual depictions involved in this offense involved prepubescent minors and minors who had not attained 12 years of age.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252(a)(4)(B).

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

1. As a result of the violations of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252, set forth in this information, defendant

ULRIC MILLER

shall forfeit to the United States of America any visual depiction described in Section 2252 and any matter containing such depictions, and any property used or intended to be used to commit or promote the commission of the offenses, including, but not limited to:


- 1) Black desktop computer, make and model unknown
- 2) Toshiba Satellite laptop computer, S/N 96040550Q
- 3) Seagate hard drive, S/N 5MT2M0R7
- 4) Western Digital hard drive, S/N WMATR1154890

2. If any of the property subject to forfeiture, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:

- (a) cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- (b) has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third party;
- (c) has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court;
- (d) has been substantially diminished in value; or
- (e) has been commingled with other property which cannot be divided

it is the intent of the United States, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p), to seek forfeiture of any other property of the defendant up to the value of the property subject to forfeiture.

All pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 2253.
