INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about July 9, 2012, in Lehigh County, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, and elsewhere, defendant

GEORGE WILLIAM SCHANTZ,

knowingly used a facility and means of interstate commerce, that is, the Internet and a mobile device, to attempt to knowingly persuade, induce, and entice Minor #1, to engage in sexual activity for which a person can be criminally charged under Commonwealth of Pennsylvania law, to wit: 18 Pa.C.S.A §§ 901 and 3122.1 (attempted statutory sexual assault), and 18 Pa.C.S.A. § 901 and 3126(a)(7) (attempted indecent assault).

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2422(b).

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

As a result of the violations of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2422, set forth in this indictment, defendant

GEORGE WILLIAM SCHANTZ

shall forfeit to the United States, property, real or personal, used or intended to be used to commit or to facilitate the commission of such offense or any property traceable to such property, and any property, real or personal, constituting or derived from any proceeds obtained directly or indirectly as a result of such offense, including, but not limited to: an HTC mobile phone, bearing serial number HT1CMMB00419 and a Hewlett Packard Pavilion laptop bearing serial number 5CD21425RC.
