**ORDER**

AND NOW, this 8th day of December, 2020, upon consideration of the Government's Motion for Alternative Victim Notification Under 18 U.S.C. § 3771(d)(2), it is hereby ORDERED that the motion is GRANTED. Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3771(d)(2) and for the reasons set forth in the motion, the Court finds that the number of crime victims in this case makes it impracticable to accord all of the crime victims the rights described in 18 U.S.C. § 3771(a). As a result, it is ORDERED that the government may provide notice to the large number of victims in this case by using the Justice Department's website for large cases, <http://www.justice.gov/largecases>, to direct victims to a case-specific website where all required notices will be posted, and by issuing a press release informing individuals who believe they may be victims to access the Justice Department website for more information. It is also ORDERED that victim notification at the corrections stage will be provided through the Bureau of Prisons's website, <http://www.bop.gov>.
