INDICTMENT

SEPTEMBER 2015 TERM - at Norfolk, Virginia

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

COUNT 1
(Felon in possession of ammunition)

From on or about December 23, 2013, to on or about March 20, 2015, in the Eastern District of Virginia, the defendant, WESLEY PAUL HADSELL, having been previously convicted in a court of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, did knowingly and unlawfully possess in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce ammunition, and did receive ammunition which had been shipped and transported in interstate and foreign commerce.

(In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(1), 924(a)(2) and 924(e).)

FORFEITURE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER ALLEGES THAT:

Pursuant to Rule 32.2(a), the defendant is hereby notified that, if convicted of the violation charged in Count 1 of this Indictment, the defendant shall forfeit to the United States all ammunition involved in or used in such violation. This property includes, but is not limited to: approximately 80 rounds of Geco 9mm Luger ammunition.
