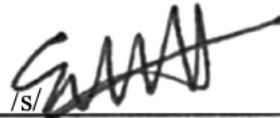
**ORDER AUTHORIZING
ALTERNATIVE PROCEDURES FOR VICTIM NOTIFICATION**

Having reviewed the United States' Motion for Order Authorizing Alternative Procedures for Victim Notification, ECF No. 29, which is unopposed, and good cause being shown:

IT IS ORDERED that the United States' motion is **GRANTED**. The United States shall provide any notifications required by 18 U.S.C. § 3771 or 18 U.S.C. § 3663A to the pool of potential victims in the above-captioned case through the Internet.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the United States shall use a case-specific page on the website of the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Eastern District of Virginia where all required notices would be posted, direct potential victims of which it is aware to that webpage, and issue a press release informing those who believe they may be potential victims to this website.
