**ORDER**

Having considered the United States' CONSENT MOTION FOR ORDER AUTHORIZING ALTERNATIVE PROCEDURES FOR VICTIM NOTIFICATION ("MOTION") (ECF No. 9), and there being no objection by the defendant, and for good cause shown, it is hereby ORDERED that the MOTION (ECF No. 9) is granted. It is further ORDERED that:

(1) The United States shall provide any notifications required by 18 U.S.C. § 3771 to the pool of potential victims in this case through the Internet; and

(2) The United States shall create a webpage on the United States Attorney's Office's Eastern District of Virginia's website where all required notices will be posted; direct potential victims of which it is aware to that webpage; and issue a press release informing those who believe they may be potential victims to this website.
