Dear Agency/Organization Executive:

I wanted to make you aware that the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) is in the midst of grant application season, and the DOJ grantmaking agencies have announced numerous federal funding opportunities for fiscal year (FY) 2024. The attached document is an overview to increase your awareness about DOJ grant opportunities and make it easier to find and access needed information, all to help you successfully navigate the process of applying for a DOJ grant.

Although the U.S. Attorney's Office (USAO) cannot write your grant application or provide technical assistance in the grant application portals (e.g., [JustGrants](#), [Grants.gov](#)), we can help make connections to the right people to answer your questions. Additionally, we may be interested in collaborating on projects and actively participating on a project team, particularly those projects that correspond with a USAO priority area – and without the need to be budgeted into the project. The USAO has prioritized violent crime, hate crimes, illicit fentanyl enforcement, and child exploitation.

Applying for federal grants is not a simple process, but we are confident that the information and resources provided in this document will help agencies and organizations in the District of Idaho understand how best to position themselves to identify funding opportunities and apply for funding.
