These are the residents that raised concern in Silver Lake:

[REDACTED] 30 Day ARD 6/29/11 (RVB) I did look at the entire billing period. The ARD date was the only day that the Very was hit. – agitation noted prior to ard and after by PT , on the 30th increased confusion in daily note by OT , nursing made aware, decline in participation. Documentation warrants some decrease in minutes but was ramped quick.

[REDACTED] 30 Day ARD 6/29/11 (RUB) I did look at the entire billing period. The ARD and 1 other day were the only days that the Ultra was hit.- noted 737, 702, 748, 698, 698 and so on.. appears trying to ramp down a bit. Not as obvious as some others. Think we would be ok with this one.

[REDACTED] 14 Day 6/17/11 (RUB)- significant drop.. ramped back up for 30 day, will watch for this going forward. Time frame indicative of changes in PD.

[REDACTED] 30 Day 7/21/11 (RHC)- this one was not that bad like [REDACTED] 379, 324, 294 and then ramps back up a bit to make the H .. think this is ok

[REDACTED] 30 Day ARD 7/2/11 (RUB)- agree with you, this one was ramped way too quickly, problematic leader going on at this time.

[REDACTED] 14 Day ARD 6/28/11 (RUA)- after review of this one, believe he was at a level where staff thought he had not much else to do, PT keeps writing rollator 200 feet, OT addresses balance? They needed direction at that time to think out of the box and decrease in minutes secondary to us not patient

[REDACTED] 14 day ARD 6/27/11 (RVC)- clearly when reviewing the planner, too many group minutes

[REDACTED] 5 Day ARD 7/21/11 (RVB) and 14 Day ARD 7/29/11 (RVB)-staffing an issue this particular week and too many group minutes.
