

**RELEASE**

In consideration of the payment of \$1,750,000, and contingent upon receipt of full payment, the City of Boston, hereby releases Bechtel Infrastructure Corp. ("Bechtel"), a Nevada corporation with a principal place of business in Frederick, Maryland, PB Americas Inc. ("PB") f/k/a Parsons Brinckerhoff Quade and Douglas, Inc., a New York corporation with a principal place of business in New York, New York and Bechtel Parsons Brinckerhoff ("B/PB"), a joint venture of Bechtel and PB, with its principal place of business in Boston, Massachusetts, their respective corporate heirs, successors, assigns, affiliates, and parent corporations, including all employees, officers, directors, servants, attorneys, and agents thereof, from all causes of action, claims and damages relating to or arising out of the July 10, 2006 incident in which concrete ceiling panels and associated components over the eastbound travel lanes on the I-90 Connector tunnel fell onto the roadway and crushed a traveling vehicle, resulting in the death of the passenger and injury to the driver. Within fourteen (14) calendar days of the receipt of full payment, the City of Boston shall execute and file a stipulation of dismissal with prejudice with respect to Bechtel, PB, B/PB and Bechtel Corporation f/k/a Bechtel Civil, Inc. and Bechtel Civil & Minerals, Inc. in Commonwealth of Massachusetts, et al. v. Bechtel Corporation, et al., Civil Action No. 06-04933 B.L.S. (Massachusetts Superior Court, Suffolk Division).
