

CLANDESTINE LAB SITE SAFETY COURSE AND CLAN LAB RESPONDER RECERTIFICATION

This 3-day / 20-hour class prepares officers to serve as the OSHA required site safety officer at the scene of clandestine labs. This is an advanced course that covers other clan labs not covered in the Basic Clandestine Lab Safety course, including conversion labs for the liquid methamphetamine smuggled into the United States by the Mexican drug cartels. The first day of class serves is a Clan Lab Responder Recertification. The students will be taught how to conduct the annual refresher training and also provided with the material to complete the training. Respiratory Fit Testing instruction is followed by a practical exercise, training students how to conduct the annual fit testing for their agency. Students work hands on with clandestine laboratory specific safety equipment to learn how to maintain and calibrate it. The class ends with students developing a site specific safety plan when given a scenario which requires students to make safety decisions based on OSHA protocol.

Course topics include:

- National, State, & Local Policy & Trends Update
- Methamphetamine Production
- Toxicology
- Chemical and Physical Hazards
- Personal Protective Equipment and Respiratory Protection
- Air Monitoring
- Hazard Assessment
- Site Control

Class size is limited to the first 40 students. All equipment needed during the training will be provided. It is the agency's responsibility to provide PPE equipment for their certified officers once in the field. **Men must be clean shaven for the fit-testing portion of the class.**
