INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

COUNT ONE

On or about May 6, 2016, in Volusia County, in the Middle District of Florida,

**ANTHONY JEROID CUE
and
JOLENE MARY CUE**

the defendants herein, each having been convicted of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, did knowingly possess, in and affecting interstate commerce, a Bryco Arms, Model 38-CA, .380 caliber firearm bearing serial number 1520633.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2).

COUNT TWO

On or about July 8, 2016, in Volusia County, in the Middle District of Florida,

**ANTHONY JEROID CUE
and
JOLENE MARY CUE**

the defendants herein, each having been convicted of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, did knowingly possess, in and affecting interstate commerce, the following firearms:

1. Romarm/CUGIR, Model Draco, 7.62-caliber firearm bearing serial number DR-7462-09;
2. Springfield Armory, Model XD, .40-caliber firearm bearing serial number US165444.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2).

FORFEITURES

1. The allegations contained in Counts One and Two of this Indictment are hereby realleged and incorporated by reference for the purpose of alleging forfeitures pursuant to the provisions of Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d) and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c).

2. Upon conviction of the violations alleged in Counts One and Two of this Indictment, the defendants, **ANTHONY JEROID CUE and JOLENE MARY CUE**, shall forfeit to the United States of America, pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d) and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), all firearms and ammunition involved in the commission of the offenses, including, but

firearms and ammunition involved in the commission of the offenses, including, but not limited to: one Bryco Arms, Model 38-CA, .380 caliber firearm bearing serial number 1520633; one Romarm/CUGIR, Model Draco, 7.62-caliber firearm bearing serial number DR-7462-09; and one Springfield Armory, Model XD, .40-caliber firearm bearing serial number US165444.

3. If any of the property described above, as a result of any act or omission of the defendants:
 - a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
 - b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third party;
 - c. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the court;
 - d. has been substantially diminished in value; or
 - e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be divided without difficulty,


the United States of America shall be entitled to forfeiture of substitute property under the provisions of Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p), as incorporated by Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c).


