Maximum Penalties

Possessing a firearm as a convicted felon - 10 years in federal prison.

Possessing a firearm as convicted felon (Armed Career Criminal) – Mandatory minimum 15 years, up to life, in federal prison.

Possessing a firearm after being convicted of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence - 10 years in federal prison.

Selling a firearm to a convicted felon - 10 years in federal prison.

Distributing and possessing with intent to distribute carisoprodol, a Schedule IV controlled substance - 5 years in federal prison.

Carrying a firearm during a drug trafficking crime – Mandatory minimum 5 years, up to life, in federal prison.

Abraham White	48	Daytona Beach	Pleaded guilty to possessing a firearm as a convicted felon. Sentenced in August 2015 to seven years in federal prison.
Daryl Mingo	45	Daytona Beach	Pleaded guilty to possessing a firearm as a convicted felon; possession with intent to distribute, distribution of heroin; carrying a firearm during a drug trafficking crime. Sentenced in August 2015 to 15 years in federal prison.
Theron Johnson	33	Daytona Beach	Pleaded guilty to possessing a firearm as a convicted felon. Sentenced in November 2015 to one year in federal prison.
James Jackson	23	Daytona Beach	Pleaded guilty to possession of cocaine; possessing a firearm as a convicted felon; carrying a firearm during a drug trafficking crime. Sentencing hearing set for August 17, 2016.
Dan Reed	40	Daytona Beach	Federal jury trial June 2016, convicted of possessing a firearm as a convicted felon. Sentencing hearing set for September 19, 2016
