On or about March 10, 2025, in the Middle District of Florida, the defendant,

did knowingly and willfully make a threat, which he understood and meant the words as a true threat, to take the life of, and to inflict bodily harm upon the President of the United States, by writing and delivering a letter to a Charlotte Correctional Institute Official stating in substance that he intended to kill Donald J. Trump, the President of

All in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 871.


