INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

COUNT ONE

From in or about early May 2018 and continuing through in or about early July 2018, in the Middle District of Florida, and elsewhere, the defendants,

CHARLIE WAYNE HARRISON, JR.

a/k/a "Wank",

TRINI THOMAS, JR.,

ALLISON NICOLE VALDEZ,

JAMES EDWARD MOSS,

DWAYNE EDWARD MOSS,

JASMINE JANAY PATTERSON,

GEORGIANA ARMENAKIS

a/k/a "Pookie"
a/k/a "Pook",

DERICK LATRELLE WOODS,

BRIAN ADOLPH MCLAREN, JR.,

CHRISTOPHER VALSECHI,

CHANTAL MONIQUE HARRISON,

did knowingly, willfully, and intentionally conspire with each other and other persons, known and unknown to the Grand Jury, to distribute a controlled substance, which violation involved 50 grams or more of methamphetamine (actual), a Schedule II controlled substance, and 1 kilogram or more of heroin, a Schedule I controlled substance, and is therefore punished under 21 U.S.C. § 841(b)(1)(A).

It was part of the conspiracy that the conspirators would perform acts and make statements to hide and conceal and cause to be hidden and concealed the purpose of the conspiracy and the acts committed in furtherance thereof.

All in violation of 21 U.S.C. § 846.

COUNT TWO

On or about January 31, 2018, in the Middle District of Florida, and elsewhere, the defendant,

CHARLIE WAYNE HARRISON, JR. a/k/a "Wank",

did knowingly and intentionally distribute a controlled substance, which violation involved 50 grams or more of methamphetamine (actual), a Schedule II controlled substance and is therefore punished under 21 U.S.C. § 841(b)(1)(A).

In violation of 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(A).

COUNT THREE

On or about February 9, 2018, in the Middle District of Florida, and elsewhere, the defendant,

CHARLIE WAYNE HARRISON, JR. a/k/a "Wank",

did knowingly and intentionally distribute a controlled substance, which violation involved 50 grams or more of methamphetamine (actual), a Schedule II controlled substance and is therefore punished under 21 U.S.C. § 841(b)(1)(A).

In violation of 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(A).

COUNT FOUR

On or about March 20, 2018, in the Middle District of Florida, and elsewhere, the defendant,

CHARLIE WAYNE HARRISON, JR. a/k/a "Wank",

did knowingly and intentionally distribute a controlled substance, which violation involved 50 grams or more of methamphetamine (actual), a Schedule II controlled substance and is therefore punished under 21 U.S.C. § 841(b)(1)(A).

In violation of 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(A).

COUNT FIVE

On or about May 4, 2018, in the Middle District of Florida, and elsewhere, the defendant,

CHARLIE WAYNE HARRISON, JR. a/k/a "Wank",

did knowingly and intentionally distribute a controlled substance, which violation involved 50 grams or more of methamphetamine (actual), a Schedule II controlled substance and is therefore punished under 21 U.S.C. § 841(b)(1)(A).

In violation of 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(A).

COUNT SIX

On or about May 15, 2018, in the Middle District of Florida, and elsewhere, the defendants,

CHARLIE WAYNE HARRISON, JR.

a/k/a "Wank",

JAMES EDWARD MOSS,

JASMINE JANAY PATTERSON,

aided and abetted the possession with intent to distribute a controlled substance, which violation involved 50 grams or more of methamphetamine (actual), a Schedule II controlled substance, and 1 kilogram or more of heroin, a Schedule I controlled substance, and is therefore punished under 21 U.S.C. § 841(b)(1)(A).

In violation of 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1), 841(b)(1)(A) and 18 U.S.C. § 2.

COUNT SEVEN

On or about May 21, 2018, in the Middle District of Florida, and elsewhere, the defendant,

CHARLIE WAYNE HARRISON, JR. a/k/a "Wank",

did knowingly and intentionally distribute a controlled substance, which violation involved 50 grams or more of methamphetamine (actual), a Schedule II controlled substance and is therefore punished under 21 U.S.C. § 841(b)(1)(A).

In violation of 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(A).

COUNT EIGHT

On or about June 23, 2018, in the Middle District of Florida, and elsewhere, the defendant,

DERICK LATRELLE WOODS,

did knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance, which violation involved heroin, a Schedule I controlled substance, and is therefore punished under 21 U.S.C. § 841(b)(1)(C).

In violation of 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C).

COUNT NINE

On or about June 24, 2018, in the Middle District of Florida, and elsewhere, the defendant,

ALLISON NICOLE VALDEZ,

did knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance, which violation involved 50 grams or more of methamphetamine (actual), a Schedule II controlled substance, and 100 grams or more of heroin, a Schedule I controlled substance, and is therefore punished under 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(b)(1)(A) and 841(b)(1)(B).

In violation of 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(A) and 841(b)(1)(B).

FORFEITURE

1. The allegations contained in Counts One through Nine are incorporated by reference for the purpose of alleging forfeiture pursuant to the provisions of 21 U.S.C. § 853.

- 2. Upon conviction of a violation of 21 U.S.C. § 846 and/or 841, the defendants shall forfeit to the United States, pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 853(a)(1) and (2), any property constituting, or derived from, any proceeds the defendants obtained, directly or indirectly, as a result of such violation, and any property used, or intended to be used, in any manner or part, to commit, or to facilitate the commission of, such violation.
- 3. The property to be forfeited includes, but is not limited to, the following:
 - a. a 2014 black Chevrolet Corvette, VIN 1G1YF3D78E5116270;
 - b. a 2008 white Hummer H3, VIN 5GTEN13EX88116445; and
 - c. a 2016 white Porsche Panamera, VIN WP0AA2A70GL000145.
- 4. If any of the property described above, as a result of any acts or omissions of the defendants:
 - a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
 - b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third party;
 - c. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court;
 - d. has been substantially diminished in value; or

e. has been commingled with other property, which cannot be divided without difficulty,

the United States shall be entitled to forfeiture of substitute property pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 853(p).
