INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

COUNT ONE

On or about February 24, 2018, in the Middle District of Florida, the defendant,

MICHAEL GLENN CHOPE,

did employ, use, persuade, induce, entice and coerce a minor, Child Victim 1, to engage in any sexually explicit conduct for the purpose of producing visual depictions of such conduct, which visual depictions were produced using materials that had been mailed, shipped, and transported in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce by any means.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 2251(a) and (e).

COUNT TWO

On or about February 24, 2018, in the Middle District of Florida, the defendant,

MICHAEL GLENN CHOPE,

did employ, use, persuade, induce, entice and coerce a minor, Child Victim 1, to

engage in any sexually explicit conduct for the purpose of producing visual depictions of such conduct, which visual depictions were produced using materials that had been mailed, shipped, and transported in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce by any means.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 2251(a) and (e).

COUNT THREE

On or about May 9, 2015, in the Middle District of Florida, the defendant,

MICHAEL GLENN CHOPE,

did employ, use, persuade, induce, entice and coerce a minor, Child Victim 1, to engage in any sexually explicit conduct for the purpose of producing visual depictions of such conduct, which visual depictions were produced using materials that had been mailed, shipped, and transported in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce by any means.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 2251(a) and (e).

COUNT FOUR

On or about May 9, 2015, in the Middle District of Florida, the defendant,

MICHAEL GLENN CHOPE,

did employ, use, persuade, induce, entice and coerce a minor, Child Victim 1, to engage in any sexually explicit conduct for the purpose of producing visual depictions of such conduct, which visual depictions were produced using materials that had been

mailed, shipped, and transported in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce by any means.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 2251(a) and (e).

FORFEITURE

1. The allegations contained in Counts One through Four of this Indictment are hereby re-alleged and incorporated by reference for the purpose of alleging forfeiture, pursuant to the provisions of 18 U.S.C. § 2253.

2. Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 2253, upon conviction of an offense in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 2251, the defendant, MICHAEL GLENN CHOPE, shall forfeit to the United States, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 2253, all of his interest in:

a. Any visual depiction described in 18 U.S.C. §§ 2251, 2251A, or 2252, 2252A, 2252B, or 2260 of Chapter 100, of Title 18, United States Code, or any book, magazine, periodical, film, videotape, or other matter which contains any such visual depiction, which was produced, transported, mailed, shipped, or received in violation of this chapter:

b. Any property, real or personal, constituting or traceable to gross profits or other proceeds obtained from such offense; and


c. Any property, real or personal, used or intended to be used to commit or to promote the commission of such offense or any property traceable to such property.

3. If any of the property described above, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:

- a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third person;
- c. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court;
- d. has been substantially diminished in value; or
- e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be subdivided without difficulty;

the United States shall be entitled to forfeiture of substitute property pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 853(p), as incorporated by 18 U.S.C. § 2253(b).




