INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

COUNT ONE
(Biological Weapon Hoax)

On or about March 28, 2020, in the Middle District of Florida, and
elsewhere, the defendant,


JAMES JAMAL CURRY,

did engage in conduct with the intent to convey false and misleading information, that is, that the defendant was infected with the COVID-19 virus and was intentionally spreading the virus to other individuals, under circumstances where such information may reasonably have been believed, that indicated that an activity had taken, and was taking, and would take place that would constitute a violation of 18 U.S.C. § 175(a), specifically, that the defendant knowingly had possessed, was possessing, and would possess, and also that the defendant knowingly had transferred, was transferring, and

would transfer, a biological agent, that is, the COVID-19 virus, for use as a weapon.

All in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1038(a)(1) and (a)(1)(A).
