INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

COUNT ONE

Between on or about September 17, 2019, through on or about
September 18, 2019, in the Middle District of Florida, the defendant,

ISALAH REED,

did knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute and did
distribute a controlled substance, which violation involved a mixture and
substance containing a detectable amount of fentanyl, a Schedule II controlled
substance, and a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of heroin,
a Scheduled I controlled substance.

All in violation of 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C), and 18 U.S.C.

§ 2.

FORFEITURES

1. The allegations contained in Count One of the Indictment is hereby realleged and incorporated by reference for the purpose of alleging forfeiture under 21 U.S.C. § 853.

2. Upon conviction of the violations alleged in this Indictment, punishable by imprisonment for more than one year, the defendant,

ISAIAH REED,

shall forfeit to the United States, pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 853, any:


- a. Property constituting and derived from any proceeds the defendant obtained, directly or indirectly, as a result of such violations; and
- b. Property used and intended to be used in any manner or part to commit and to facilitate the commission of such violations.

3. If any of the property described above, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:

- a. Cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- b. Has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third party;
- c. Has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court;
- d. Has been substantially diminished in value; or


- e. Has been comingled with other property which cannot be divided without difficulty, the United States of America shall be entitled to forfeiture of substitute property under 21 U.S.C. § 853(p).


