## INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

### COUNT ONE

On or about February 5, 2020, in the Middle District of Florida, the defendant,

## ROSSONNO BORDERS, JR.,

knowing that he had previously been convicted in any court of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, including:

Grand theft third degree \$300-\$20,000, on or about June 1, 2017, did knowingly possess, in and affecting interstate commerce, a firearm and ammunition, that is, a SCCY Industries firearm, 3 rounds of WIN 9MM LUGER ammunition, and 2 rounds of F C 9MM LUGER ammunition.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2).

#### **FORFEITURE**

- 1. The allegations contained in Count One are incorporated by reference for the purpose of alleging forfeiture pursuant to the provisions of 18 U.S.C. § 924(d) and 28 U.S.C. § 2461(c).
- 2. Upon conviction of a violation of 18 U.S.C. § 922(g), the defendant shall forfeit to the United States, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 924(d) and 28 U.S.C. § 2461(c), all firearms and ammunition involved in or used in the violation.
- 3. The property to be forfeited includes, but is not limited to, the following: a SCCY Industries firearm, 3 rounds of WIN 9MM LUGER ammunition, and 2 rounds of F C 9MM LUGER ammunition.
- 4. If any of the property described above, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:
  - a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
  - b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third party;
  - c. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the court;
  - d. has been substantially diminished in value; or
  - e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be divided without difficulty,

the United States shall be entitled to forfeiture of substitute property under the provisions of 21 U.S.C. § 853(p), as incorporated by 28 U.S.C. § 2461(c).
