**INDICTMENT**

The Grand Jury charges:

**COUNT ONE**

On or about October 8, 2016, in the Middle District of Florida, the defendant,

WEST WILD HOGS,

a person over the age of 18, did unlawfully, knowingly, and willfully seize, confine, inveigle, kidnap, abduct, and carry away, and hold for some benefit, to wit:

companionship and otherwise, R.L.—who had not attained 18 years of age and to whom the defendant is not a parent, grandparent, brother, sister, aunt, uncle, or individual having legal custody—and, in committing, and in furtherance of the commission of, the offense, did willfully travel in interstate commerce and did willfully transport R.L. in interstate commerce,

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1201(a)(1) and (g).

**FORFEITURE**

1. The allegations contained in Count One of this Indictment are hereby realleged and incorporated by reference for the purpose of alleging forfeitures pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 981(a)(1)(C) and Title 28, United States Code,

Section 2461(c).

2. Upon conviction of the offense in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1201 set forth in Count One of this Indictment, the defendant,

WILD WEST HOGS,

shall forfeit to the United States of America, pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 981(a)(1)(C) and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), any property, real or personal, which constitutes or is derived from proceeds traceable to the offense.

3. If any of the property described above, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:

- a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third party;
- c. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the court;
- d. has been substantially diminished in value; or
- e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be divided without difficulty,

the United States of America shall be entitled to forfeiture of substitute property pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p), as incorporated by Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c).


