REWARD

The FBI is offering a reward of up to \$5,000 for information leading to the location and arrest of Charles William Dexter III.

REMARKS

Dexter III has previously resided in Minneapolis, Minnesota. He has ties to Minneapolis, Minnesota; Houston, Texas; and Sacramento, California.

CAUTION

The FBI's Minneapolis Field Office is assisting Homeland Security Investigations and the Bloomington Police Department in Minnesota with the search for Charles William Dexter III. Dexter III is wanted for his alleged involvement in the sex trafficking of a minor.

Dexter III was charged with engaging in sex trafficking of a minor in the Hennepin County District Court, Minneapolis, Minnesota, on August 17, 2020. A state warrant was issued for his arrest the same day.

Dexter III was charged with sex trafficking of a minor in the United States District Court for the District of Minnesota, Minneapolis, Minnesota, on February 19, 2021. A federal warrant was issued for his arrest on the same day.
