JUSTIN E. HUBBARD,

knowingly falsified records and documents with the intent to impede, obstruct, and influence the investigation and proper administration of a matter within the jurisdiction of a federal agency, *to wit* the United States Navy and the United States Environmental Protection Agency.

2. Specifically, defendant falsified documents, including chain of custody forms generated on May 31, 2012, the data from which was incorporated into maps and site systematic sampling results emailed to the United States Navy on or about June 6, 2012. The forms were false because they purported to show that soil samples 28-47 in Survey Unit 1 were taken from the 'North Pier' area of the Hunter's Point Naval Shipyard Superfund Site during radiological remediation work, when in fact they had been taken from a different location believed to contain non-radioactive soil.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 1519 and 2.
